STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Designating Saco as the Seat of the District Court for Eastern York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 108-A, § 3, sub-§ XXXI, amended. The last sentence of subsection XXXI of section 3 of chapter 108-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 386 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

'The District Court for Eastern York shall be held at ~~Biddeford~~ Saco.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 108-A, § 4, sub-§ X, amended. Subsection X of section 4 of chapter 108-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 386 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

X. Tenth District. The 10th district consists of the divisions of Eastern York (~~Biddeford~~) (Saco), Western York (Sanford) and Southern York (Kittery).'
