STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Mortgages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 177, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 177 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 4. Foreclosure in 6 months. Possession obtained in either of these 3 modes and continued for # year 6 months forever forecloses the right of redemption.'
