HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 59, L.D. 82, Bill, "An Act
Increasing the Rate of Minimum Wages and Otherwise
Revising the Minimum Wage Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title, and
inserting in place thereof the following title:

'An Act Increasing the Rate of Minimum Wages.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R.S., c.30, §132-C, amended. Section 132-C of chapter
30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 362 of the
public laws of 1959 and as amended, is further amended to read
as follows:

'Sec. 132-C. Prohibition of employment except as provided
for. By reason of the declaration of policy set forth in section
132-A and in the protection of the industry or business and in
the enhancement of public interest, health, safety and welfare,
it is declared unlawful for any employer to employ any employee
except as otherwise provided in sections 132-A to 132-J at the
rate of less than ~~¢~~ \$1.15 per hour.'
