## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Purchase of Lands by Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37-A, § 19-A, additional. Chapter 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 331 of the public laws of 1959, is amended by adding a new section 19-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 19-A. Authority to purchase lands, build dams, etc. The salmon commission is authorized to purchase or lease, within this State, lands, dams and other structures, to acquire flowage rights, mill privileges and rights-of-way, and to build dams and other structures, for the purpose of conservation of Atlantic sea run salmon.'
