IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Local Option Question on Sale of Malt Beverages in Hotels and Clubs Only.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 61, § 2, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 2 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 3 of chapter 355 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended, is further amended to read as follows:
 - 'III. Shall licenses be granted in this city or town for sale herein of malt liquor (beer, ale and other malt liquors) to be consumed on the premises of class A restaurants only? (Beer and Ale in Restaurants, Hotels and Clubs)'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 61, § 2, sub-§ III-A, additional. Section 2 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 3 of chapter 355 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection III-A, to read as follows:
 - 'III-A. Shall licenses be granted in this city or town for sale herein of malt liquor (beer, ale and other malt liquors) to be consumed on the premises of hotels and clubs only? (Beer and Ale in Hotels and Clubs)'
