AN ACT Prohibiting Use of Pesticides Near Waters of the State.

R. S., c. 141, § 11-B, additional. Chapter 141 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 11-B to read as follows:

'Sec. 11-B. Chemical insecticides near waters. Chemical insecticides, fungicides, herbicides and other chemical pesticides shall not be used or placed within 20 feet of any river, stream, lake, pond or tidal waters. Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100, and costs, for each offense.'
