AN ACT Relating to the Use of Purse, Drag or Stop Seines in Part of
Damariscotta River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1959, c. 155, § 9, sub-§ IV, repealed and replaced. Subsection IV of section 9 of chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1959 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘IV. In Damariscotta River above a line drawn from Annahils Point in the Town of Boothbay to the north end of Hodgdon’s Island in the Town of Bristol, excepting the use of drag seines between the above line and the Ledges, for all except alewives.’
