STATE OF MAINE SENATE 101st LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 47, L. D. 97, Bill, "An Act Relating to Matching State Funds with Local Chambers of Commerce to Obtain New and Aid Expansion of Present Industries."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "Local Chambers of Commerce" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Municipalities'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 5th line from the end the words "local chambers of commerce or boards of trade" and inserting in place thereof the word 'municipalities'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the first and 2nd lines the words "chamber of commerce or board of trade" and inserting in place thereof the word 'municipality'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, a new section as follows:

'Sec. 3. Municipal funds. Municipalities are authorized to raise and appropriate funds to carry out the purposes of this act and may authorize local chambers of commerce or boards of trade to act for them'
