SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 48, L. D. 98, Bill "An Act Revising
the Law Relating to Closing-Out Sales."

Amend said Bill in subsection V of that part designated
"Sec. 79-A." by striking out in the 3rd and 4th lines the underlined
words "no person or persons shall continue the business for which
the license was granted" and inserting in place thereof the following
underlined words 'the person or persons to whom the license was
granted shall not continue the business'.
