RESOLVE, in Favor of Oscar Hanley of Newcastle.

Oscar Hanley; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,500 to compensate Oscar Hanley of Newcastle for damages to his well by the addition of harmful salt content and for damages by the taking of some 5 feet of his land, both as a result of the highway construction project number F026-1(21) by the State Highway Commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Damage was done to Oscar Hanley's well and land by construction project number F026-1(21). Some 5 feet of land the entire length of the frontage of his home was taken for this new construction. Damage for the land taken, and to the remainder of the land will be processed through the Land Damage Board. One of the greatest items of damage is the change in the nature of the water in his well. The water now has a salt taste. This is due to the blasting done by the Highway Commission when they were doing the construction work on the land in front of Mr. Hanley's house.
