SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 53, L. D. 103, Bill, "An Act Placing Vocational Teachers in Unclassified Service."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by inserting after the word "Teachers" the words 'and Certain Personnel in the Department of Education'

Further amend said Bill by inserting immediately after the enacting clause the following section:

"Sec. 1. R.S., c. 41, §8, amended. The first and 2nd sentences of section 8 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'The board, in addition to other duties prescribed by law, shall select, subject to the Personnel Law, such personnel as may be needed for the efficient operation of the department, excepting personnel of the Department of Education for whom teaching certificates are required by the State Board of Education who shall be selected by the board from nominations by the commissioner.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the 15th line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'

Further amend said Bill, in the 21st line, by inserting after
the underlined word "institutions" the underlined words 'and personnel
of the Department of Education for whom teaching certificates are
required by the State Board of Education'
