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**Resolve, Naming the Max L. Wilder Memorial Bridge at Belfast.**

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**Max L. Wilder Memorial Bridge at Belfast; named. Resolved:** That the State Highway Commission is authorized to name the new, high level bridge across Passagassawaukeag River at Belfast, in the County of Waldo, the Max L. Wilder Memorial Bridge, in memory of the late Max L. Wilder of Augusta, who was bridge engineer for the said commission from 1928 to 1962 and under whose direction the bridge was designed and that the engineering employees of the State Highway Commission are authorized to erect, on said bridge, without expense to the State of Maine, a suitable plaque in memory of the said Max L. Wilder.
