STATE OF MAINE SENATE 101st LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 60, L. D. 110, Bill, "An Act Relating to Rules and Regulations in Fishing."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the underlined 4th paragraph of "Sec. 9." and inserting in place thereof the underlined paragraph:

'Notice of the hearing to be held, the time and place thereof, together with the listing of all proposed changes, shall be by publication once a week, for 2 successive weeks prior to the hearing, in a newspaper published in the county where the waters are situated, or if no newspaper is published there, in a newspaper having state-wide circulation; and notice of such hearing shall be sent to the clerks of the towns in which the waters are situated and to the county commissioners if such waters are located in whole or in part in the unorganized territory.'
