CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 62, L. D. 112, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Admission of Attorneys to the Bar of the State of Maine."

Amend said Bill in the 17th line of section 3 by adding after the underlined word "years" the underlined words 'or he has successfully completed 2/3 of the requirement for graduation from a law school approved by said board, and thereafter has pursued the study of law in the office of some attorney within the State of Maine for at least one year'
