AN ACT Relating to Application of Federal Social Security to Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 65, § 1, amended. The last sentence of section 1 of chapter 65 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 65 of chapter 429 of the public laws of 1957 and as amended by chapter 38 of the public laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows :

'This chapter shall not apply to ~~teachers and~~ firemen who are under a state or local government pension or retirement plan, except teachers at the Maine Maritime Academy.'
