STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Members of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 10, § 2, amended. The first sentence of the first paragraph of section 2 of chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 373 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives shall receive \$7,600 \$2,500 for the regular session of the Legislature, and shall be paid for travel at each legislative session once each week at the rate of 5c per mile to and from his place of abode, the mileage to be determined by the most reasonable direct route.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 10, § 2, amended. The first sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 2 of chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 2 of chapter 373 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'The President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives shall each receive $\$_{1,850}$ $\$_{2,750}$ for each regular session of the Legislature, with the same mileage as other members, and subject to the same deduction in case of each absence.'

Sec. 3. Effective date. This act shall take effect on the first Wednesday of January, 1963.

Sec. 4. Appropriation. There shall be appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$165,000 to carry out the purposes of this act.
