

STATE OF MAINE SENATED 101st LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 33, L. D. 124, Bill, "An Act to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding after section 2 a new section to read as follows:

"Sec. 2-A. R. S., c. 20-A, §10, amended. The first sentence of section 10 of chapter 20-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 394 of the public laws of 1961 and as repealed and replaced by the public laws of 1963, is amended to read as follows:

'The rules of evidence as applied in civil cases in the Superior Court shall be observed, except that this section shall not apply to hearings under chapter 61.'

<u>Sec. 2-B. Effective date.</u> Section 2-A shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature."
