SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 33, L. D. 124, Bill, "An Act to  
Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding after section 2 a new section to  
read as follows:

"Sec. 2-A. R. S., c. 20-A, §10, amended. The first sentence  
of section 10 of chapter 20-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted  
by section 1 of chapter 394 of the public laws of 1961 and as  
repealed and replaced by the public laws of 1963, is amended to  
read as follows:

'The rules of evidence as applied in civil cases in the Superior  
Court shall be observed, except that this section shall not apply  
to hearings under chapter 61.'

Sec. 2-B. Effective date. Section 2-A shall become effective  
91 days after adjournment of the Legislature."
