**Improvements at Indian Reservation; appropriation. Resolved:** That there is appropriated the sum of \$10,000 from Unappropriated Surplus of General Fund to Department of Health and Welfare to provide improvements in water supply, disposal system and homes located at the Indian Reservation at Pleasant Point, Washington County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Improvements at Indian Reservation are needed as follows:

1. Plumbing, and basic water to 5 family units	\$ 3,000
2. Septic tanks	6,000
3. Paint for 10 homes	1,000
