RESOLVE, Reimbursing Bay Ferry Corporation for Loss of Its Business.

Bay Ferry Corporation, reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$20,000 to be paid to the Bay Ferry Corporation for loss of its business because of ferry service now provided by the Maine Port Authority.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The ferry "Sea Wind" ended service at end of mail contract on July 5, 1960. The Bay Ferry Corporation is now asking reimbursement for being put out of business by the "William Silsby." The requested \$20,000 would pay off debts and repay stockholders.
