STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Construction of Picnic Areas Along the Maine Turnpike.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 97-A, additional. Chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 97-A to read as follows:

'Sec. 97-A. Picnic areas along the Maine Turnpike. The Maine Turnpike Authority shall construct and maintain along the Maine Turnpike 6 picnic areas northerly and 6 picnic areas southerly where in the opinion of the authority it may seem advisable.'
