STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Turnpike Signs Designating Conditions in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 149-B, additional. Chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 149-B to read as follows:

'Sec. 149-B. Signs on Maine Turnpike designating conditions. The Maine Turnpike Authority shall erect and maintain along the Maine Turnpike north near the turnpike entrance a sign of such design that it shall be conspicuous and readable when traveling at the maximum lawful speed, designating conditions in Maine, such as skiing, hunting, fishing, foliage and fire.'
