# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Definition of Industrial Project under Maine Industrial Building Authority Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38-B, § 5, sub-§ III, ¶ A, amended.** Paragraph A of subsection III of section 5 of chapter 38-B as enacted by section 1 of chapter 421 of the public laws of 1957, and as repealed and replaced by chapter 341 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

'A. Any building or other real estate improvement and, if a part thereof, the land upon which they may be located, and all real properties deemed necessary to their use by any industry for the manufacturing, processing or assembling of raw materials or manufactured products and for the purposes of research and development for industrial and manufacturing enterprises or associations thereof:'
