IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing on Lake Wassookeag, Dexter, Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Ice fishing on Lake Wassookeag, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing that part of Lake Wassookeag in Dexter, Penobscot County, lying 600 feet westerly of the Guy H. Hall Memorial Bridge on the road leading from said Dexter to Sangerville, Route #23, so called, to the southerly shore by the ski slope, thence in a northerly direction to the public picnic area, to ice fishing.
