STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Reporting by Those Who Treat Gunshot Wounds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 137, § 20, amended. The first sentence of section 20 of chapter 137 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Any person who professionally treats a human being for a wound apparently caused by the discharge of a firearm shall immediately report the same to the county attorney or sheriff or any of his deputies or any police officer of the county in which the wound was treated.'
