**AN ACT to Provide for Acceptance of Federal Funds by State Park
Commission.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 36, § 34, sub-§ VI-B, additional. Section 34 of chapter 36 of the Revised Statutes as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection VI-B to read as follows:

‘VI-B. Federal funds. To accept and receive funds from the Federal Government for all purposes relating to parks and recreational areas. The Treasurer of State shall be the appropriate fiscal officer to receive such federal funds and the State Controller shall authorize expenditures therefrom as approved by the commission.’
