IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Exempting Swine Under Nine Months of Age from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ V, ¶ C, amended. Paragraph C of subsection V of section 10 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended by chapter 187 of the public laws of 1959 is further amended to read as follows:

'C. Mules and horses less than 6 months old; colts of draught type less than 3 years old; neat cattle less than 18 months old; sheep to the number of 35 and all lambs under one year old; swine to the number of 10 **and all swine under 9 months old**; domestic fowl to the number of 50; goats to the number of 35; and all kids less than one year old.'
