IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Sick Leave and Vacations for Employees of Sheriffs' Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 174, amended. Section 174 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Section 255 shall apply to sick leave and vacation of the employees of the sheriff's department of each county.'
