AN ACT Relating to Payment to Sheriffs for Attendance upon the Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 150, sub-§ XV, amended. Subsection XV of section 150 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read as follows:

‘Payment for attendance, service and travel as specified in this subsection shall not be made for those days within a court session when no court is held.’
