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**AN ACT Relating to License Plates for Disabled or Paraplegic Veterans.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended.** The 5th paragraph from the end of section 13 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

'Any veteran who has lost both legs or the use of both legs and who has registered his motor vehicle without the payment of a fee as provided in this section **upon certification by the Veterans Administration** shall be issued special designating plates to be used in addition to the regular registration plates. Such designating plates shall be issued by the Secretary of State upon certification by the Veterans Administration. The registration plates so issued shall bear the initial "V" before the plate number.'
