### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Nonresident Hunting License Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 73, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 73 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'For the purposes of this section a resident shall include a nonresident who owns real estate in Maine. The license may be issued to such nonresident by the clerk or agent in the town in which the applicant owns real estate.'
