## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Increasing Nonresident Fishing License Fee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 37, § 39, sub-§ V, amended.** The 3rd and 7th sentences of subsection V of section 39 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, are amended to read as follows:

'A 15-day license shall cost \$5.75 \$6.75 and shall remain in effect for 15 days from the date as designated in the license.'

'Any resident or nonresident of the State, who is a citizen of the United States, may procure a license good for  $\frac{3}{7}$  7 consecutive days as designated in the license upon the payment of  $\frac{3}{75}$  \$4.75, 25c to be retained by the agent.'
