AN ACT Relating to Report of Bureau of Social Welfare in Child Custody Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 166, § 69, amended. The last sentence of section 69 of chapter 166 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Such report shall be available ~~for examination by~~ to counsel at least 10 days before the custody action is held ~~before a decree is made, and upon~~. Evidence must be submitted by counsel to the court before a decree is made that the interested parties, when available, have examined such report. Upon request of any interested party the court shall require the person making the report to testify subject to cross-examination and to rebuttal.'
