AN ACT Relating to Removal of Paupers to Town of Settlement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 94, § 29, amended. Section 29 of chapter 94 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 29. Overseers' notice and request to town liable; relief may be refused in certain cases. Overseers shall send a written notice, signed by one or more of them, stating the facts respecting a person chargeable in their town, to the overseers of the town where his settlement is alleged to be, requesting them to remove him, which they ~~may~~ shall do by a written order directed to a person named therein, who is authorized to execute it. If the overseers of the town, where the settlement is alleged to be, shall refuse to order the pauper to be so removed or if such pauper, so ordered to be removed, shall refuse to obey such order and to return to the town of his settlement, then the overseers of the town wherein said pauper is found may refuse to furnish him relief.'
