COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 160, L.D. 210, Bill, "An Act to
Incorporate the Town of Winterport School District."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 4th paragraph
of the emergency preamble.

Further amend said Bill in section 8 by striking out, in
the 3rd line, the words "or sublease"; and by striking out, in
the 4th line, the words "or leased"

Further amend said Bill in section 9 by striking out all of
the last sentence of the first paragraph and inserting in place
thereof the following paragraph:

'This act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof
immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters
voting at said meeting; provided the total number of votes cast
for and against the acceptance of this act at said meeting equaled
or exceeded 10% of the total vote cast for all candidates for
Governor in said town at the next preceding gubernatorial election.'
