STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys to Construct a Car Ferry Ramp at Peaks Island.

Car ferry ramp for Peaks Island; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Port Authority the sum of \$75,000 for the construction of a motor operated car ferry ramp at Forest City Landing on Peaks Island, such construction to be with the approval of the Public Utilities Commission.

Such appropriation shall not lapse until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1960 and 1961 it was agreed that a combination ferry and passenger dock at Forest City Landing should be constructed. However, available funds were not sufficient to build such dock. Peaks Island needs a dock which will adjust to the changing tides so that ferry service may be maintained at all times. It is estimated that \$75,000 is needed to accomplish this result.
