**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys to Promote and Advertise Maine's Ski
Business.**

Department of Economic Development; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$30,000 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Economic Development for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 to promote and advertise Maine's fast growing ski business. Said appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1965.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The ski business in Maine is one of its fastest growing recreational industries. It should be promoted and advertised.
