**AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Renovation of Buildings and Purchase of
Equipment at Northeastern Maine Vocational Institute.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, buildings must be renovated and equipment purchased before classes in vocational education can be conducted at Northeastern Maine Vocational Institute; and

Whereas, a minimum of 6 months is required for such renovation and purchase; and

Whereas, classes in vocational education are needed in September 1963; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for necessary renovation of buildings and purchase of equipment at Northeastern Maine Vocational Institute. In order to provide for the necessary renovation of buildings and purchase of equipment for vocational education at Northeastern Maine Vocational Institute, there is appropriated from

the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$408,500 to the Department of Education. This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1965.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
