STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Use of Capitol Park Snow Dump.

Money appropriated to the Bureau of Public Improvements. Resolved: That there is appropriated to the Bureau of Public Improvements from the General Fund, out of any funds not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$12,000 to defray additional costs resulting from the use of the Capitol Park snow dump or Kennebec River instead of the snow dump to the south of the State Office Building.

Any balance in the appropriation on June 30, 1964 shall be carried forward to be expended for the same purposes during the 1964-65 fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Residents in the area immediately adjacent to the snow dump to the south of the State Office Building have objected to the continued use of this snow dump. Discontinuance of its use will add substantially to the cost of removing snow from the state-operated parking areas.
