**RESOLVE, Authorizing Completion and Printing of a Digest of the Opinions
of the Law Court.**

Completion and printing of digest authorized. Resolved: That the Attorney General is authorized and instructed to complete the compilation of a digest of the opinions of the law court of the State of Maine in such order and form as it seems best to him. To aid him in the completion and printing of this work he is empowered to employ clerical assistance as may be necessary; and be it further

Resolved: That the Governor and Council are authorized to provide for the printing and sale and fixing the price of the digest. For the purpose of carrying out this resolve, the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1965.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

To date, 157 volumes of Maine Reports have been published, covered by published digests inclusive to volume 146. A compact, down to date digest is badly needed, and because of the nature of the book, its production should be regarded as a duty of the State in the same manner as are the Maine Reports.
