RESOLVE, to Purchase Fifty Copies of "The History of Augusta."

"The History of Augusta"; purchase of. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$450 for the State to purchase 50 copies of the book entitled "The History of Augusta," written by Charles E. Nash, at \$9 per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This book covers the early history of the Town of Augusta and contains valuable source material not previously printed. It has long been the practice of the Legislature to encourage the publication of works which help to preserve the history of the State, by purchasing copies for distribution to libraries. It seems particularly fitting that the Legislature show its interest in the history of the state's capitol.
