RESOLVE, to Reimburse City of Bangor for Support of Theresa Vallencourt.

City of Bangor; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$873.80 to be paid to the City of Bangor to reimburse it for supplies and medical care furnished to Theresa Vallencourt, state pauper, from January, 1959 through August, 1960.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Theresa Vallencourt married Charles Bates in Bangor on March 3, 1952. They were divorced January 29, 1953. Mrs. Bates took her maiden name of Vallencourt back again. A child, Rachel Ann Vallencourt, was born August 8, 1956.

At the time of the divorce Charles Bates had no settlement in any city or town of this State, therefore, Theresa Vallencourt took a non-settled status at that time and held it when aid to dependent children was granted in September, 1956. ADC was continuous until relief was granted in 1959.
