STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Town of Woolwich for Loss of Tax Revenue of Property Owned by State.

Town of Woolwich; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,000 to be paid to the Town of Woolwich for loss of taxes by the acquisition of the Henry Seegar place by the State Highway Commission in 1957.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The H. Seegar place is located on the northerly side of route I at the intersection of the Nequassett Road. The State Highway Department acquired this property for the purpose of constructing a divided highway but later changed its plans and built an undivided road in the center of its right-of-way making removal of the Seegar place unnecessary. The State has been renting this property to a tenant who enjoys the use of educational and other municipal services provided by the Town of Woolwich.

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
