RESOLVE, in Favor of Carroll Beal of Skowhegan.

Carroll Beal; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$268 from the General Highway Fund to be paid to Carroll Beal of Skowhegan, as a full and final settlement against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to his property caused by the construction of a highway by his property.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In constructing the highway, the driveway to Mr. Beal's home had to be cut back 35 feet. As a consequence, an elm tree had to be removed and Mr. Beal paid \$268 to have this done.
