HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 206, L.D. 275, Bill, "An Act to
Provide Aid to Blind Persons in Voting."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the part designated
subsection "IV." and inserting in place thereof the following:

"IV. Blindness. A voter who is blind may obtain assistance
in marking his ballot from 2 election officers, not of the
same political faith, but may be of the same political
faith at primary elections, or father, mother, brother,
sister, husband, wife or child as he may select, providing
that said aide is of voting age and that no candidate for
election shall act as aide."
