RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Pembroke, Washington County.

Appropriation; Town of Pembroke. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Highway Fund to the Town of Pembroke the sum of \$25,000 to construct so-called Wilbur Hill Road in Young's Cove, West Pembroke, to connect with the newly constructed road to the Salt Water Reversing Falls.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the present time this road is very narrow and more or less like a country road. This road at the present time is unable to accommodate tourists.
