SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 208, L. D. 277, Bill, "An Act
Designating Mount Desert Island as Game Management Area."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Referendum; effective date; certificate to Secretary of State.'

This act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the Town of Mount Desert at any annual town meeting called and held for that purpose.

The town clerk shall reduce the subject matter of this Act to the following question: "Shall the Act designating Mount Desert
to
Island as a game management area/be open for hunting of deer at the discretion of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, passed by the 101st Legislature, be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.

This act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting at said meeting; provided the total number of votes cast for and against the acceptance of this act at said meeting equaled or exceeded 20% of the total vote cast for all candidates for Governor in said town at the next preceding gubernatorial election.

The result of the vote shall be declared by the municipal officers of the Town of Mount Desert and due certificate thereof shall be filed by the town clerk with the Secretary of State.'
