SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 208, L. D. 277, Bill, "An Act Designating Mount Desert Island as Game Management Area."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Referendum; effective date; certificate to Secretary of State.'

This act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the Towns of Mount Desert, Bar Harbor, Southwest Harbor and Tremont at their annual town meetings in 1964 called and held for that purpose.

The town clerks shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall the act designating Mount Desert Island as a game management area to be open for hunting of deer at the discretion of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, passed by the 101st Legislature, be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.

This act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of all the legal voters of said towns voting at said meetings; provided the total number of votes cast for and against the acceptance of this act at said meetings equaled or exceeded 20% of the total vote cast for all candidates for Governor in said towns at the next preceding gubernatorial election.

The result of the vote shall be declared by the municipal officers of the Towns of Mount Desert, Bar Harbor, Southwest Harbor and Tremont and due certificate thereof shall be filed by the town clerks with the Secretary of State.'
