RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters in Piscataquis County.

Fishing in certain waters in Piscataquis County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue rules and regulations as follows:

Closing Little Sourdnahunk Lake, T5 R11, to all fishing from one hour after sunset to one hour before sunrise of each day and establishing a daily limit of 5 fish and closing to all fishing except fly fishing.

Closing the section of Sourdnahunk Lake in T4 R10, known as the thoroughfare, from the outlet dam northerly approximately 1,000 feet to red posts set on either shore of said thoroughfare to all fishing.
