RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in the West Branch of the Penobscot River,
Piscataquis County.

Fishing in West Branch of Penobscot River, Piscataquis County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing the West Branch of the Penobscot River, T₃ R₁₁, T₃ R₁₀, T₂ R₁₀, Piscataquis County, to all fishing except fly fishing from red posts set at the upstream side of the Big Eddy, so called, downstream to red posts set below the mouth of the confluence of Sourdnahunk Stream and the West Branch of the Penobscot River.
